


Day 3: Monday 6th June 2016

Weather  mood: 😊

Location: Valley (GR SH 28 5802)

Parked the car on Newlands Park estate and took the path down to the beach.

Took a left turn (W) when we got onto the beach until we came across the extensively folded outcrop (~1m in height and extending 10m)

Hazards:

- Working on a beach section so be aware of tides.
- Slippery uneven surfaces, wear walking boots with good ankle support.

Aims:

- Identify rock type(s) + folds within the outcrop.
- Complete an annotated field sketch of the folds.
- Take strike and dip measurements of the fold limbs.
- Consider the geological history of the locality.
